## Article 1 Purpose

The purpose of the Rules of Competition Exhibition .., is a set of rules to regulate all matters relating to competitions showing that they are promoted and organized by the European Taekwondo Union.

### (Interpretation)

The purpose of Article 1 is to ensure the unification of the display of Taekwondo competitions all over the country. Any race that does not follow the fundamental principles of these rules can not be recognized as a display of Taekwondo competition.

## Article 2 Application

The Rules of Competition will be applied in all competitions promoted and / or organized by the European Taekwondo Union.

However, any association member who wishes to change any of the Rules of Competition, you can do with the approval of the ETU.

### (Interpretation)

Obtain approval: Any organization wishing to make a change somewhere in the existing rules must deliver to the ETU the content of what you want to amend the reasons for the change. For approval must be received by the ETU one month before the competition.

1) Change in category, 2) Increase or decrease in the number of arbitrators 5 or 7) Change of location of the Bureau or medical committee of inspection, etc.. 4) Duration of the proceedings, etc..

These points may be amended upon application and approval of the ETU. However, as regards: valid points, point deductions (canchong), and area of competition may not be modified under any circumstances.

### 2.1 Area apply.

1) The rules will also be the basis for meetings and competitions with other similar disciplines.  
2) The point of the rules is to standardize each technique and organize the materials needed for a tournament.

### 2.2 General.

1) The prerequisite for participation in a tournament is to be a member belonging to the ETU and / or autonomous federations.

Exceptions are subject to a previous permission by the management of competitions.

- 2) The teams will be represented by its own team leader or coach. Only he / she will be authorized to deal with the failure to obtain the draw.
- 3) The content of the exhibit is free and can use combinations technical breaks and Hambom Kyorugui. (Only use Taekwondo techniques, and make the inclusion of techniques from other disciplines such as Hapkido, Judo, etc.).
- 4) For the competitors are not permitted the use of necklaces, bracelets, earrings, rings, watches and others.

### Article 3 Area of Competition.

The competition area will measure 12 x 12 m, depending on the metric system (decimal) and is smooth and unhindered.

The surface is coated with an elastic fabric or soft material, new carpets taekwondo. However, if necessary, the area of competition can be mounted on a platform that does not exceed a height from the base of 50-60cm. and the outside of the boundary line must be tilted with a slope of less than 30 degrees, for the safety of competitors.

#### 3.1. Demarcation of the area of competition.

- 1) The area between the 12 x 12 m area of competition will be called
- 2) The demarcation of the area of competition will be distinguished by areas of different color or marked with a white line 5cm wide, in the event that the entire surface of a single color.

#### 3.2. Indication of the positions.

1. Position of judges. Seven judges must sit at 1 m. Distance and Area of Combat 2 m. in between, four competitors and looking at three in the back of them. The boundary line adjacent to four judges should be considered the boundary line # 1, followed by boundary line # 2, # 3 and # 4, meaning clockwise from the boundary line # 1. Judges are positioned in the sense of clockwise from the left side of the boundary line # 1.  
If 5 judges, three judges must be positioned facing the athletes and the other two in the back of the athletes in the same order of the 7 judges.

Both with five or seven judges, three judges, two or more difficult to appreciate breaks and penalties for not breaking the cork, as well as a secretary and a scorer to take control of the execution time.

2. Position to the arbitrator. An arbitrator must be placed in the seat of Judge No. 1. 1.

4. Position of the judge's table. The judge must be placed outside the area of combat, 2 m. section from the center of the boundary line # 2.

7. Position of the inspection table. The inspection table should be placed at the entrance to the area of fighting outside the corner of the boundary lines # 3 and # 4, taking into account the possibilities of the installation.

(Explanation)

Elastic fabric: Only tarps or soil approved by the ETU should be used in championships Exhibition.

Color: The color of the surface of the fabric or wallpaper should not dismiss a reflection gaudy or be tired to hear the participants or spectators. The color should also be appropriately similar to general look of the event.

The Bureau of Inspection: The Bureau of Inspection, the Inspector will monitor whether the competitor's equipment is approved by the ETU and if it fits properly. If that is not appropriate, the competitor must appropriate.

Article 4 Competitors

1. Qualifications of the competitors

- 1) Have th nationality from the participating country..
- 2) Take the card grades, or Pum Dan Taekwondo issued by the National Taekwondo Federation.
- 3) Having the age not les than 15 years.

2. Uniform competitor

- 1) Competitors must wear only the uniform approved by the ETU or WTF .
- 2) Be a dobok taekwondo, clean and unobtrusive advertising is allowed.
- 3) The male competitors can not under any garment dobok.
- 4) The female competitors may be below the shirt or top dobok considering that to be white.

### 3. Medical Monitoring

- 1) At the Taekwondo events promoted or organized by the ETU, Autonomous Federations and / or partners, any use or administration of drugs or chemical substances described in the Anti-Doping Rules are prohibited.
- 2) The ETU, all I could carry out medical checks deemed necessary to determine if the participant has committed violation of the Anti-Doping Rules of the ETU. Any winner who refuses to submit to such control or that is proven to have committed such a violation, should be removed from the final position, and the winner will be transferred to the next competitor in line with the positions of the competition.
- 3) The Organizing Committee is responsible for fulfilling the requirements to carry out medical checks.

All details concerning the doping must be handled according to the Anti-Doping Rules WTF/IOC.

### Article 5 of the Competition Standings

- 1) Team: Each team will consist of a minimum of six (6) and a maximum of nine (9) competitors, whether male, female or mixed, may be assisted or not assisted by any other participant who is not part of the team exhibition.

### Graduation Rule 6 (Ring)

Graduation will be at first Dan degree.

### Article 7 Method of Competition

1. In all championships exhibition organized or promoted by the ETU must have at least three registered, having arrived less they voided.
2. Form of competition: Teams of competitors will perform a single round, and its content is free, can use music in their show.
  - 2.1. Placement of equipment: may be placed and distributed freely within the track avoiding difficult finding the perfect technique by judges.

3. Any change in the way of competition, to maintain the schedule, will be decided by the organizing committee of the same.

4. The order of action will be decided by lot.

5. Competition system: (single round).

Round one: The 1st, 2nd and 3rd place teams should be among the competitors, plus the score of the judges, having the highest score. To make that amount will be removed the highest and lowest given by the judges.

In case of tie

Follow the following process:

1.- It is the highest sum previously canceled and the team score will have more wins.

(If the tie ... ..)

2.- add footnote lowest previously canceled and the team score will have more wins.

(If the tie ... ..)

3.- It will be won by the team that has fewer components.

(If the tie ... ..)

5.- It is declared the winner, the team whose sum of age of its components is less.

Article 8 Term of the competition.

The time available to teams for their exhibition will be from: a minimum of two (2) minutes and thirty (30) seconds and a maximum of three (3) minutes. Previously may use thirty (30) seconds to accommodate ramp and preparation of materials, etc.

Material breach Article 9.

1) shall porespan, with dimensions of 40x30 cm. and a thickness of 2 cm.

Note:

Special breaks in the allowed dimensions are 80x30 cm. and a thickness of 2 cm.

2) Do not allow any other material.

3) material breach shall be verified by a judge, so that they can not be prepared beforehand. (Cuts made earlier to avoid possible bugs, etc.)..

4) You can use one type of weapons such as knives, guns, or truncheon (police protection), but soft plastic or rubber, having a prior

5) Do not allow any other weapons.

#### Article 10 Prohibited Acts / penalties.

1. The use of animals such as pigeons or other birds, and so on. Is strictly prohibited, which carry the automatic deletion of the offending team.

2. Penalties for any prohibited act must be declared by the court No 1.

3. Penalties are defined as "Gam-jeom" (deduction of penalty points).

4. The following acts are classified as prohibited acts, must be declared "Gam-jeom"

a) Deliver unwelcome comments or any misconduct by the competitor or coach.

b) It is a trial judge's No. 1 assess whether a coach or competitor committed the code of conduct violation.

c) Competitors must not disrupt or coach, or leave your area described during the course of the competition.

(Interpretation)

If a team is penalized with two (2) deductions, the arbitrator must be declared loser by penalties. The deduction of points, "Gam-jeom" defined in this Article is different from those deductions to be judges in their ratings.

#### Article 11 Procedures of the competition.

##### Procedures before and after the competition

1. Call competitors.

The names of the teams should be announced three times beginning three minutes before the scheduled start of the competition, with one minute intervals. Any team that does not appear in the area of competition one minutes after the scheduled start of the competition, should be considered as if it had been withdrawn and should be eliminated.

2. Physical inspection and the uniform.

After being called, the competitors must pass a physical inspection and uniform in the table specific inspection by an inspector appointed by the ETU Competitors must not show any signs of aversion, and should not wear anything that is not allowed.

3. Enter the area of competition

Following the inspection, the competitors must enter the waiting area of competition and may be accompanied by a coach.

#### 4. Beginning and end of the competition.

The competition will begin with the statement: "Shi-jak" (start), the team captain and must end with the statement: "Ba-ro" (unemployment) by the team captain. The timekeeper should record the time for action.

#### 5. After the end of the exhibition.

Competitors must remain standing in their respective positions and do a salute to the mandate of the team captain: "Cha-ryeot" (Attention), "Kyeong-rye" (greetings). Then, standing, waiting for the declaration of scoring by the judges.

#### 7. Exit of competitors.

### Article 12 Criteria for scoring.

The score should be given under the rules of the ETU.

#### 1. Accuracy of the Technique of Taekwondo.

- 1) Accuracy of basic movements
- 2) Details of each technique.
- 3) Difficulty of the art.

#### 2. Presentation

##### 1) Ability / Skill

- a. Precisión range of motion
- b. Equilibrio
- c. Velocidad and power

##### 2) Expression

- a. Fuerza / Rhythm
- b. Expresión energy
- c. Coreografía.

### Article 13 Methods of scoring.

1.- The valuation of the exhibit will be global, each judge scoring the final set of the same.

2.- The judges table will also be able to increase rate or deduct the final grade, taking into account the following order of ratings.

2.1.- INCREASE POINTS: The final score may increase when used within the exhibition the following jumps with a correct implementation. If the execution of these jumps is not correct, do

not appreciate the view of the table to improve the final score, but in no case may give negative points for poor performance.

First (1st)

Breaks maximum difficulty: + 0.30 points.

Second group (2)

Breaks medium difficulty: + 0.20 points.

The criterion for awarding these points will be:

+ 0'30 join points when a minimum of two (2) technical group.

+ 0'20 join points when a minimum of two (2) techniques of the second group.

0.10 + join points when a minimum of two (2) techniques of the third group.

Join + 0.60 points if performed a minimum of two (2) techniques first group, two (2) and the second two (2) the third.

+ 0'50 join points if performed a minimum of two (2) techniques first group and two (2) the second.

+ 0'40 join points if performed a minimum of two (2) techniques first group and two (2) the third.

+ 0'30 join points if performed a minimum of two (2) techniques second group and two (2) the third group.

2.2 .- DEDUCTION POINTS:

Each time a competitor loses balance and falls will

deduct (-) 0.20 points, adding up all the falls and through deduction in the final score.

(Interpretation)

Drop by drop means that which is produced when making or after a technique where reception taekwondo in soil is not controlled but is suddenly hit the floor losing balance or taking a clear contact with this any body part other than my feet hands.

Whenever a competitor comes out of the line limit is 12x12 deduct (-) 0.50 points, adding up all outputs and applying deduction in the final score.

(Interpretation)

Exit 12x12 (limit) is defined as an exit competitor takes one or both feet outside the limit of 12x12.

Any failure in breaking corks, will be penalized with minus (-) 0.10 points, adding all the bugs and make the deduction to the final score.

(Interpretation)

Break is considered failed:

- 1 .- When the cork does not break, that is left whole, even after have impacted the right way.
- 2 .- When the broken piece of cork is very small (a little break a corner or just where it is subject)
- 3 .- The area with which it hits the cork is not relevant to the technology. For example: a run and break with Dolly knee, tibia, or the body of a bug in the distance.
- 4 .- When you move in a clear and ostentatious to find the cork impact right after it failed in the distance or height.
- 5 .- When the cork is broken by the competitor who holds.

If a team exceeds the time limit or does not reach the minimum, will be deducted from the final score the following points:

Not to reach the minimum of time:

Less than 2'09"deducted - 0.40 points.

From 2'10"to 2'19"is deducted - 0.30 points.

From 2'20"to 2'24"is deducted - 0.20 points.

From 2'25"to 2'29"is deducted - 0.10 points.

It passed the time limit:

From 3'01"to 3'05"is deducted - 0.10 points.

From 3'06"to 3'10"is deducted - 0.20 points.

From 3'11"to 3'20"is deducted - 0.30 points.

Over 3'21"deducted - 0.40 points

Material breach: Using materials other than those authorized in its composition and size. Corks manipulated for easier break, will be penalized with a deduction of 0.50 points in the final score.

Standard competitor (dobok): Any team that fails to comply with the requirements of article 4 point 2 shall be penalized with a deduction of 0.50 points in the final score.

The use of techniques which are recognized as other disciplines such as martial Hapkido, Judo, etc., The deduction will result in the final result of 0.50 points.

The use by competitors, necklaces, bracelets, earrings, rings, watches and other, will cause a deduction in the final result of 0.50 points.

### 3. Calculating the score

1) The ratings given by judges, are removed the highest and lowest and once this is done is calculated the average score.

2) The average score will be calculated on the final score.

3) In case of being given negative points, they must be deducted from the final score.

4) In case of positive points have been given, these must be added to the final score.

### Article 14 Publication of punctuation.

1. The final score should be announced immediately after collecting the total of the judges.

2. If using electronic scoring instruments.

2.1) A judge must place items on the electronic scoring after the exhibition, and the totals should automatically be displayed on the monitors.

2.2) The final score (points average) must be displayed on the monitor removed once the highest scores and lowest in those given by the judges.

### 3. If manual scoring

3.1) The coordinator must collect every piece of punctuation, and communicate the results to the scorer immediately after completion of the exhibition.

3.2) The scorer must pass the final score, once removed from the scores the highest and lowest, and announce or display the final score. (half point).

### Article 15 Decision and declaration of the winner.

1. The winner should be the team which, once found, minus the average and / or added, if the board of judges, has more points in total.

### Article 16 to suspend a competition.

If the competition for various reasons and to injury, the judge must declare 1 "Shi-gan" (Suspension) or "Kye-shi" (Suspension) and restart the competition from the outset, taking into consideration all aspects of the situation.

When a race is stopped due to injury, the referee must take the following steps:

1. 1 The judge should stop the competition and ordered to suspend the time scorers announcing "Shi-gan" (Suspension) or "Kye-shi" (Suspension).

2. 1 The judge must allow a competitor or competitors receiving first aid for a minute.

3. If the competitor or competitors do not demonstrate the will to continue the competition after a minute, even if it is only a slight injury, the team shall be declared by the judge # 1, removed.

### Article 17 Official Referees.

#### 1. Qualifications

1) 1). The judges must hold a Certificate of Judge National Qualifier (Referees Pumse).

2) To be Justice National Qualifier will be required to be in possession of at least 3rd Dan black belt.

## 2. Responsibilities

### 2.1. Judge No. 1 (Area Manager).

1. In ways in case of bad behavior by the coach, delegate or competitors, as attested by the Canchog (less -1 points)

2. With two cautions in Canchong (less -1 points) the team eliminated from the competition.

3. Permitirá the team once again repeat the display if any suspended due to injury or other reasons.

4. Declarará vetting team.

0.50 points deducted from the total final score of competitors if any of the following circumstances:

1. Entrar track position as a leading, bracelets, rings, watch, chain, etc..

2. Entrar track leading dobok shirt below (only in case of men)

3. Entrar shirt or carrying a track below the top dobok color than white. (only in case of females can lead shirt below dobok white).

4. Cuello of dobok than that it is the belt. (Black belt, black neck, red belt / black, red neck / black and white brown belt)

### 2.2) Judges

a. Los judges will score the overall assessment of the exhibition.

b. Los judges should give their honest opinions when you ask the head of the area.

## 3. Classification of official referees

3.1) The official referees should be classified in the following categories.

Category 1: Only judges who hold a certificate or higher national qualifications Judge and a 3rd Dan or higher should be chosen to officiate the exhibition adult competitions.

## 4. Uniform officers referees

a. Los referees must wear official uniform designated by the WTF/ETU (Gray trousers, navy blue jacket, white shirt, blue tie and white shoes taekwondo.)

(Interpretation)

The chairman of the Supervisory Board of the Competition may request the Technical Delegate to replace official referees in case the arbitrators have been appointed official incorrectly or if the Supervisory Board of the competition judges that one of the referees have led the officers assigned unfair competition have made mistakes or unreasonable.

## Article 18 Anotado.

1. The timing pad to the competition, including the suspension of time during the competition, and also to calculate, record and announce or make the total ratings shown.

## Article 19 Training and allocation of official referees.

### 1. Composition of the official referees

1) System 7 judges: 1 Area Manager, 6 judges, 3 judges table, scorer and secretary.

2) System 5 judges: 1 head of zone 4 judges, 2 judges table, scorer and secretary.

### 2. Allocation of official referees

1) The choice of a system of 7 judges or a system of 5 judges to be decided depending on the competitors participating in the competition.

## Article 20 Punishment and Appeals Committee.

Be formed in each championship, an Appeals Committee to resolve any claims that may occur in such activity.

### 1.- Composition of the Appeals Committee.

The Appeals Committee shall be chaired by the President of the territorial federation organizer, the director of referees, the technical director of the technical area championships and three (3) delegates team, chosen by lot from among the participating delegations.

### 2.- Responsibility:

The Appeals Committee of the Competition, you must make corrections for trial in accordance with its decision in regard to protests and take disciplinary action against officers, trial errors or illegal behavior, the results of which should be notified to the ERU.

The Appeals Committee of the Competition is also empowered to punish acts directly related to the administration of the competition.

The Appeals Committee may amend the final score in case of error in the sum of partial scores.

### 3.- PROCEDURE OBJECTION

1) the protest will be allowed only in writing and submitted to the organizing committee.

An official delegate of the team sheet must file a protest with the protest fee of €60 to the Appeals Committee of the competition in 10 minutes after the signal points for execution.

2) A discussion of the protest should be carried out by the Appeals Committee of the Competition excluding those in the same area of the competitors involved and a decision must be made by majority.

3) The protests will only be accepted if they relate to a miscalculation of a judge or registrar. The Protest Committee's decision is firm or organization.

(Interpretation)

The Sanctions Committee of the Competition must consist of at least five (5) members.

(Explanation)

Deliberative procedures: The procedures of deliberation to reach a resolution are:

1) After reviewing the reasons for a protest, the Council (committee) must first decide if the protest is "Acceptable" or "Unacceptable" for deliberation.

2) If necessary, the (committee) may hear the views of referees or judges.

Who is called to be decided by the Council (committee).

3) The Council (committee) must review the written entries, if it deems it necessary, after viewing information recorded on the competition and so on.

4) After deliberation, the Council (committee) should maintain the secrecy of the ballot to determine a majority decision.

5) The Chairman of the Board (committee) shall make a report documenting the outcome of the discussion and should make this publicly known result.

6) The actions required should be taken according to the decision of the Council (committee).

a. Errores in determining the outcome of the competition: the errors in calculating the score of the competition or not to identify a competitor must be changed or corrected.

## INTERPRETATIONS:

These rules must be interpreted by the ETU Technical Committee in the event of any doubt, it is settled during the tournament. The ETU Technical Committee will find a reasonable agreement in line with the goal of Taekwondo.

Medical Monitoring 1) At the Taekwondo events promoted or organized by the ETU, Autonomous Federations and/or partners, any use or administration of drugs or chemical substances described in the Anti-Doping Rules is prohibited. 2) The ETU, medical staff could carry out checks deemed necessary to determine if the participant has committed a violation of the Anti-Doping Rules of the WTF/IOC. Any competitor who refuses to submit to such control or that is proven to have committed such a violation, should be removed from the final position, and the competitor will be transferred to the next competitor in line with the positions of the competition. 3) The Organizing Committee is responsible for fulfilling the requirements to carry out checks.

All details concerning the doping must be handled according to the Anti-Doping Rules of the WTF/IOC.

## Article 5 of the Competition Standings

## Article 20 Punishment and Appeals Committee.

Be formed in each championship, an Appeals Committee to resolve any claims that may occur in such activity. 1. - Composition of the Appeals Committee. The Appeals Committee shall be chaired by the territorial President of the federation to organizer, the director of referees, the technical director of the technical area championships and three (3) delegates team, chosen by lot from among the participating delegations.

2. - Responsibility: The Appeals Committee of the Competition, you must make corrections for trial in accordance with its decision in regard to protests and take disciplinary action against officers, trial errors or illegal behavior, the results of which should be notified to the Spanish Taekwondo Federation.

The Appeals Committee of the Competition is also empowered to punish acts directly related to the administration of the competition.

The Appeals final Committee may amend the score in marries of error in the partial sum of scores.

(Interpretation) The Sanctions Committee of the Competition must consist of AT least five (5) members.

(Explanation) Deliberative procedures: The procedures of deliberation to reach to resolution plows:

1) for After reviewing the reasons to protest, the Council (committee) must first decides if the protest is "Acceptable" or "for Unacceptable" deliberation. 2) If necessary, the (committee) may to hear the views of referees or judges. Who is called to be decided by the Council (committee).

3) The Council (committee) must review the written entries, if it deems it necessary, to after viewing information recorded on the competition and under on.

4) After deliberation, the Council (committee) should maintain the secrecy of the ballot to determine to majority decision.

5) The Chairman of the Board (committee) shall make to report documenting the outcome of the discussion and should make this publicly known result.

6) The actions required should be taken according to the decision of the Council (committee).

a. Errors in determining the outcome of the competition: the errors in calculating the score of the competition or not to identify to competitor must be changed or corrected.
